There are generally three ways you are asked to write about a research problem: 1) your professor provides you with a general topic from which you study a particular aspect; 2) your professor provides you with a list of possible topics to study and you choose a topic from that list; or, 3) your professor leaves it up to you to choose a topic and you only have to obtain permission to write about it before beginning your investigation.

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1. Choosing a Research Problem - Organizing Your Social

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When you formulate a research problem, you should take into account some key factors which will help you to ensure that your research study would be measurable and that you will remain motivated. These considerations are (a) Interest, (b) Magnitude, (c) Measurement of concepts, (d) Depth of expertise, (e) Relevancy of the study, (f) Data source, (g) Ethical issues.

7 Basic Steps in Formulating a Research Problem

Defining a Research Problem. Formulating the research problem begins during the first steps of the scientific process.. As an example, a literature review and a study of previous experiments, and research, might throw up some vague areas of interest.. Many scientific researchers look at an area where a previous researcher generated some interesting results, but

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never followed up.

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For your research problem to be effective, make sure that it has these basic characteristics: Reflecting on important issues or needs; Basing on factual evidence (it's non-hypothetical); Being manageable and relevant; Suggesting a testable and meaningful hypothesis (avoiding useless answers).
