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Mainecare Income Guidelines 2014 Maine

Full MaineCare Benefit 250% \$2,659 \$3,592 2-step income test: 1. Unearned income must be under 100% of FPL. 2. Total earned and unearned income must be under 250% of FPL. Asset Limit: \$8,000 per individual or \$12,000 per couple Must be under the age of 65, have a disabling condition per the criteria of the Social Security Administration and earnings.

In order to qualify for MaineCare, you must be a resident of the state of Maine, a U.S. national, citizen, permanent resident, or legal alien, in need of health care/insurance assistance, whose financial situation would be characterized as low income or very low income.

Kids and Parents Children 18 years old or younger. Depending on income level, kids may be able to get free MaineCare or low-cost coverage through the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), formally called CubCare. MaineCare and CHIP provide the same health coverage - the only difference is the low monthly cost for CHIP. The cost for CHIP is between \$8 and \$64 per month, based on ...

Mainecare Income & Asset Guidelines

All income is based on gross monthly income; that is before any deductions are taken. Income to be counted includes all sources of income such as Social Security, pensions, profits from investments and interest earned. Asset limits for all programs are \$50,000 or less for and individual or \$75,000 or less for a couple.

Mainecare Buy-In Program Benefits & Qualifications

They must meet income guidelines, live in Maine, and be individually determined to be at "nutrition risk" by a health professional. To be eligible on the basis of income, applicants' income must fall at or below 185 percent of the U.S. Poverty Income Guidelines.

Make note, Maine is unique in that the state allows a single individual an exemption of \$8,000 in liquid assets and married couples an exemption of \$12,000. (Liquid assets include checking and savings accounts). These amounts are in addition to the Medicaid asset limit of \$2,000 for a single individual and \$3,000 for a married couple.

Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB) Program: Helps pay Part B premiums only. If you qualify for a QMB or SLMB, you automatically qualify to get Extra Help paying for Medicare prescription drug coverage. How do I qualify? In most cases, to qualify for a Medicare Savings Program, you must have income and resources below a certain limit.

In Maine if you are single and your income is less than \$1759 a month you may get help. If you are married and your income is less than \$2369 a month then you may get help. If only one person in a couple wants the help, then the income limit may be as high as \$2837 per month.
